NOTICE OF RACE

1 Organizing authority

The organizing authority is the beachclub Anemos Heist, in cooperation with the federations WWSV.

2 Venue

The competition will be held on July 27th 2024 and will be sailed at the North Sea in front of the coast of Knokke-Heist. The racing area will be at the east-side of the harbor of Zeebrugge. The regatta site is at the Beachclub Anemos, on the beach, at the end of Anemonenlaan, 8301 Knokke-Heist, BELGIUM.

3 Rules

The event will be governed by:

- 3.1. The Rules as defined in the ISAF-Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS) and any amendments.
- 3.2. The prescriptions of the Belgian Sailing and any amendments.
- 3.3. The Rules as defined in the Equipment Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (ERS) and any amendments.
- 3.4. The Class Rules and any amendments, except as any of these are altered by the NoR or S.I.
- 3.5. The Notice of Race.
- 3.6. The Sailing Instructions.

4 Advertising

The championship is designed as a Category "C" event according to ISAF Regulation 20 Advertising Code.

5 Eligibility and entry

The event is open to all multihull from the classes C1 and C3, as mentioned in the ISAF SCH Rating System.

All entrants, to be eligible for the event, shall:

- Comply with ISAF RRS Appendix 3 - Regulation 19: Eligibility Code
- Be current financial members of their National Multihull Association
- Any competitor under the age of 18 years will be required to obtain parental/guardian consent prior to commencement of the Championship

6 Fee

The Entry Fee is 40€/boat (is without BBQ). Participants have to subscribe during their registration at the regatta office. Payments (€-cash only) shall be received on site during registration.

7 Schedule

11h00 : Subscriptions at regatta office
12h00 : Skippers meeting
13h00 : First possible start
ASAP after finish : Prize giving
18h30 : BBQ (subscriptions before 12:00 am at reception!)

A maximum of 6 races are scheduled in each class.

Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration and will be posted on the official notice board.

8 Courses

The event will use windward/ leeward sausage course with gate. The course will be specified on the Notice Board at the skippers meeting 12:00 am.

9 Penalty system

Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gibe is required.

10 Scoring

The most recently published SCRS (Small Catamaran Handicap Rating System published at schrs.com) will be used.

- (a) When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 4, 5 or 6 races have been completed, the worst score per boat will be excluded.

11 Safety regulations – Complementary to the Class Rules – Safety Equipment RRS 40 applies at all times while afloat, although flag "Y" will not be displayed. This changes RRS 40.

All boats shall be equipped with

- two paddles and one flare on each crew member.
- A towing rope of 15 meters long and 6 mm in diameter.
- A righting rope of 4 meters long and 10 mm in diameter
- 2 personal flotation devices in accordance with EC specifications
- A wetsuit or drysuit are obligatory at all times while afloat
- Competitors must have a mobile phone on board, this must be used in case of emergency.

Note: lengths and diameters specified in this article have to be read as minimum.

12 Prizes

Trophy of Cathomies. Duvel and other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing Authority and only to teams who are presented by themselves.

13 Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

14 Insurance

Each participating competitor shall be insured with valid Public Liability and a Third Party Property Liability Insurance policy, with a minimum cover of 2.500.000 € or equivalent when racing at the venue of the event.
